

PUBLIC ACCESS INTERNET RULES POLICY

Seaford Public Library

The Seaford Public library provides open access to the internet. Registration is necessary to use the computer. Appointments are for one hour, and should be booked at the Reference Desk or by telephone. Only one person is allowed on each computer.

The internet is considered to be an extension of the Reference Services offered by the Library. However, the Seaford Public Library has no control over these networks and assumes no responsibility for the content, quality, or accuracy of information transmitted. Any illegal activity by a computer user is strictly prohibited.

A person under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian present to sign the Public Access Internet Form. **The internet permission sticker, either on the person's library card or school ID, MUST ALWAYS be presented at the time of sign-up.**

Please note: staff can assist in the initial start-up of the system; however, they cannot provide extended instruction.
